- HERO10 Black v1.50.70, January 2023
- HERO9 Black v1.72.70, June 2022
- HERO8 Black v2.51.75, July 2022

GoPro Set Precision Date and Time



Very important when using multiple cameras per experience.

Set Precision Date and Time (Local)

- 1. Plug in the GoPro into the uploader via the USB port.
- 2. Wait for the blue light on the dock to illuminate (it may flash 5 times).
- 3. Once the blue light turns off, unplug the GoPro.
- 4. Repeat the process for each GoPro.

Note: Only one GoPro can be plugged into the dock at one time.

It is important that you plug in ALL of the GoPro's each morning before daily operations. Failure to do this can result in clips becoming out of order due to the time stamps being out of sync!

Overview

How to flag GoPro videos for review

You must set three (3) consecutive HiLight Tags while recording a short video clip (with about one second in between)

Flagging GoPro Videos for Review

Detailed

Flagging videos for review will prevent the footage from being automatically edited and sent via email to the customer until the footage is reviewed and approved in the Revl Local Operator Portal.

How to flag GoPro videos for review

You must set three (3) consecutive HiLight Tags in a short video clip (with one second in between).

- 1. Start a short video recording
- 2. Press the [Mode Button] on the camera to insert a HiLight Tag.

Repeat pressing the [2] [Mode Button] two more times for a total of three (3) HiLight Tags with about one second in between.
